How does Traumeel® Injection therapy work for you?

Traumeel® contains highly diluted ingredients that reduce pain and inflammation associated with a broad range of conditions. A recent clinical study showed knee joint injections with Traumeel® Injection Solution in combination with Zeel® to be a safe and effective treatment of moderate to severe pain in patients with knee osteoarthritis.2 The exact mechanism of action of Traumeel® Injection Solution is not yet fully understood.

How is this therapy given?

Your doctor will administer one or a series of injections of Traumeel® Injection Solution, depending on your condition and type of pain. The drug can be applied as an intramuscular (into a muscle), subcutaneous (under the skin) or intra-articular (into a joint) injection. Traumeel® can also be combined with other drugs. For example, your doctor may recommend a local anesthetic to reduce the possible discomfort associated with the injection, add Zeel® Injection Solution for joint pain, or Spascupreel® for muscle spasms associated with back pain.

Who should NOT have this therapy?

People who:

- Are allergic to any of the ingredients of Traumeel® Injection Solution.
- Have infections or skin diseases in the injection area

How safe is the treatment with Traumeel® Injection Solution?

This therapy is considered very safe. Traumeel® Injection Solution is not known to cause any drug-to-drug interactions and reports of adverse events are exceptionally low. The following adverse events have been identified during post-marketing use. Because these events are reported voluntarily from a population of uncertain size, it is not always possible to reliably estimate their frequency or establish a causal relationship to drug exposure.

Adverse event rates reported in monotherapy use of Traumeel[®] Injection Solution: Allergic (hypersensitivity) reactions (e.g. skin allergies, redness/swelling at the injection site, even up to anaphylaxis) may occur in isolated cases.1

The safety and effectiveness of the therapy has not been established in pregnant women, lactating women, and children.1
